

3.4.1 Extension activities are carried out in the neighbourhood community, sensitizing students to social issues, for their holistic development, and impact thereof during the last five years.

The Institute has a team that arranges extracurricular and co-curricular activities for the villages' community development initiatives. These programmes give students a better understanding of rural life, villagers' issues, and potential technical solutions. Through its numerous extension initiatives, the institution has considerably benefited the local population. Few of them are listed below:

Harithaharam: All of our students and teachers take part in haritharam, a ceremony for planting and tending to new plants, as part of our commitment to environmental sustainability.

Village survey: Students and faculty participated in a village survey to better understand the community's issues and address any concerns they had, especially in regards to the impact of crop diseases and the optimal use of technology in agriculture.

Blood Group Detection and Donation Camps: There were camps where people could find out their blood type for free. Rare blood groups are found and their information is kept for future use. The same information is also shared with blood banks. Students at SDGI have given blood to sick people in the area.

Awareness Rally Programs: The institution conducted an awareness rally programs for No smoking, Cancer Awareness, No plastic etc. Through slogans and banners, the students who took part drew attention to the need and importance of the same for the people.

The Institute includes both the teaching staff and the students in its involvement in a community network. This makes it easier to learn the excellent values and duties that are necessary for healthy citizenship, an orientation towards service, and holistic development. Our students frequently arrange charitable events such as blood donation camps and tree planting events in the local community. Visits by members of the faculty and students to various charitable organisations, during which participants contribute blood and fulfil other needs (books, blankets, etc). The Institute hosts various discussions and programmes centred on the concept of value-based education. Students from the Institute, in collaboration with other charitable groups, run health check-up camps for the local populace. Extension activities were carried out by the Institute with the goal of imparting academic learning experience, values and skills not only to students but also to faculty members. The institute could use more of these types of activities to energise the atmosphere there. The mission of the institution is to serve all aspects of society by disseminating information and offering high-level educational opportunities. The purpose of these extension activities is twofold: first, to assist the students in developing their personalities as a whole, and second, to assist the students in improving their job prospects once they have finished their academic training. The purpose of these extension activities is to inspire students to continue their

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

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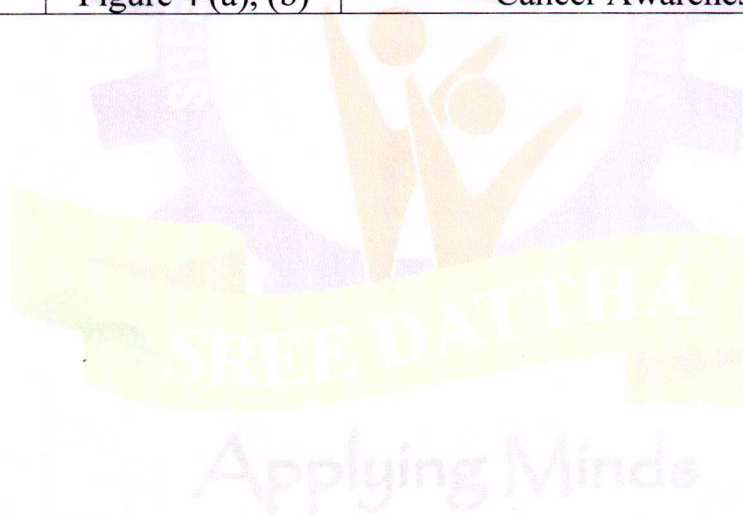

Figure 1: Harithaharam

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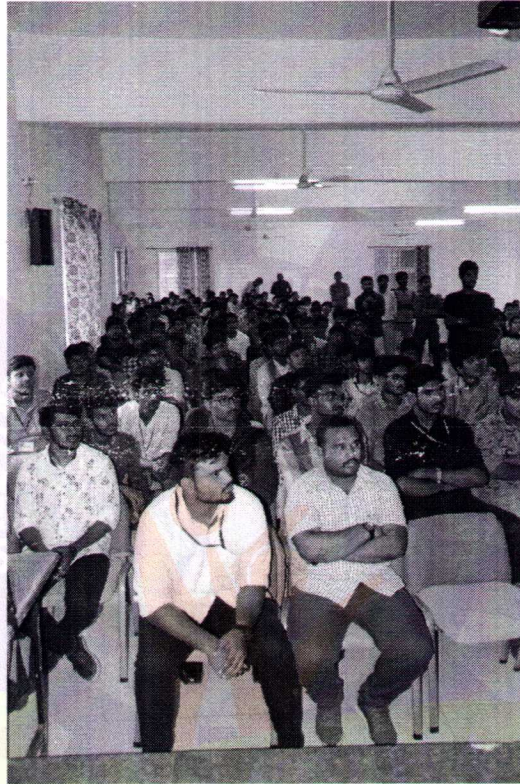

Figure 2: No Plastic Awareness Rally

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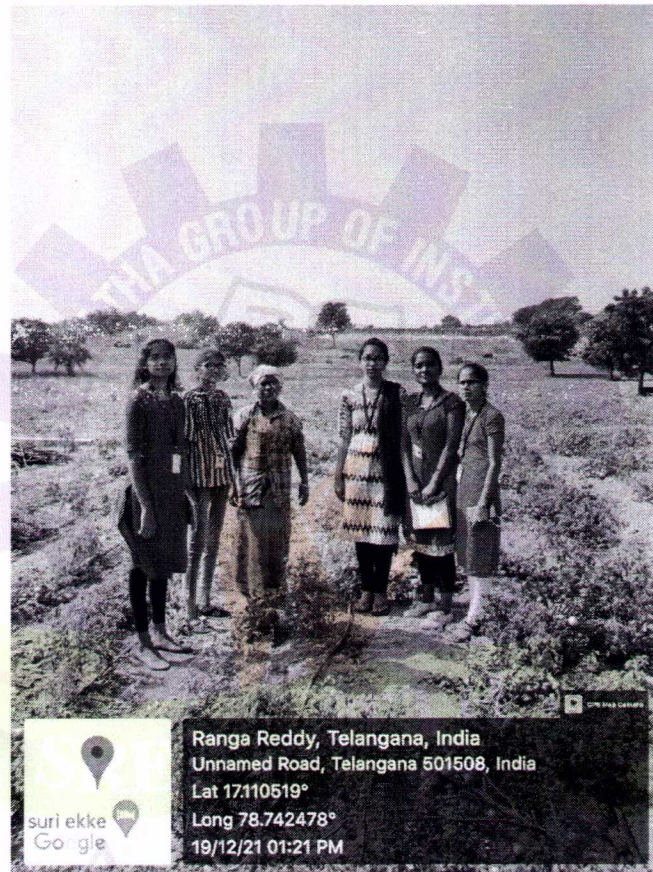
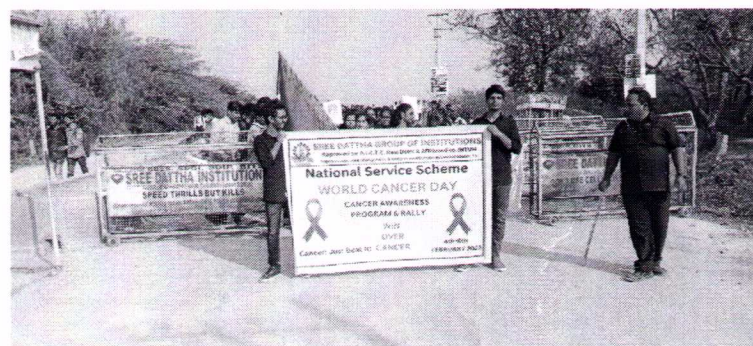


Figure 3: Village trip for problem identification
